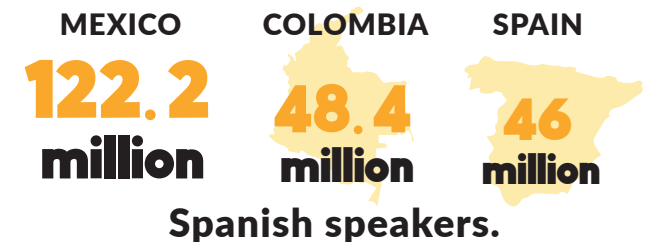
MEXICAN ECOSYSTEMS

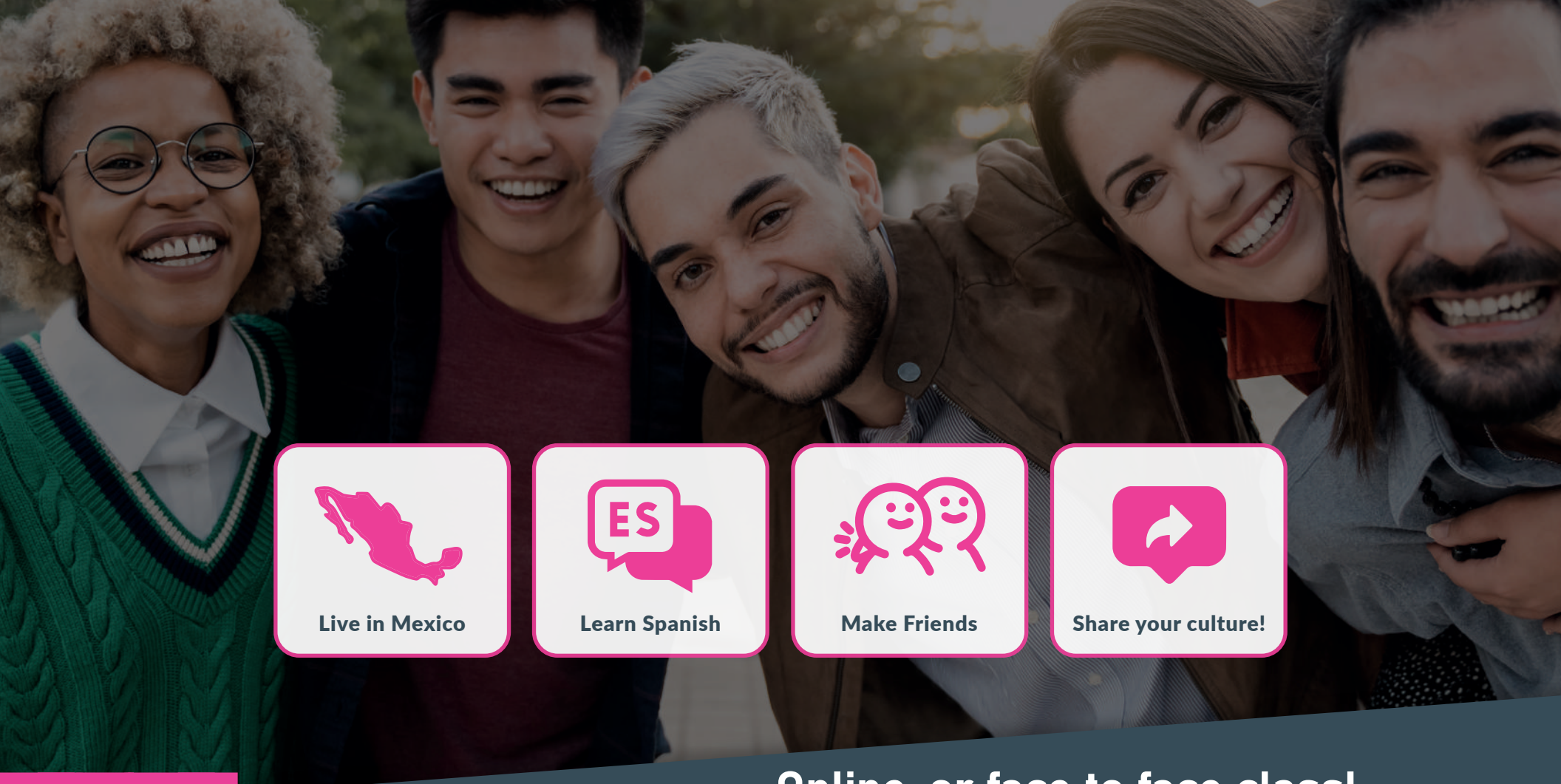
